

Summary

- 1. FD now has a strong foothold in CCBH's grocery store chains
- 2. Desirable results on a large scale can be achieved rapidly (~6 months)
- 3. Only a single chain showed no FD improvement
- 4. "All hands on deck" approach was key, as usual with preparedness.
- 5. Continued vigilance will ensure momentum in stores
- 6. FD must be on equal footing with traditional food safety

Food Defense Tips

- Post large signs stating that all visitors to non- public areas are required to sign-in and obtain a visitor's badge
- Employees escort unidentified visitor to management for I.D./verification
- Roster of authorized visitors with photos
- · Contact the appropriate agency for verification
- Manager/employee escort visitors
- Secure non-public exterior doors (self-closing/locking)
